

SPPU Calendar AY 2021-2022





CCE – Comprehensive Concurrent Evaluation Policy

IIMHRD (W) is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune. Institute follows the guidelines and syllabus as prescribed by the Pune University. CCE is for 50 marks. As per the Pune University MBA Syllabus, guidelines are provided for CCE & Rubrics. Accordingly IIMHRD(W) has drafted the following policy for CCE – Comprehensive Concurrent Evaluation.

- 1. The course teacher shall prepare CCE Scheme for their respective subject(s). CCE Scheme could be as per the University prescribed methods (As mentioned in CCE table below)
- 2. For 3 credit course minimum of three CCE methods to be adopted (Each should be of minimum 25 marks. Total marks are then to be converted to 50 marks. For 2 credit course, minimum 2 CCE Schemes, for 1 credit course at least 1 CCE method to be adopted



Mechanism and Conduction of CCE:

- The scheme of comprehensive concurrent evaluation is prepared by the course teacher and approved by the director of the institute.
- The examination committee takes care of conducting internal examinations. Prime responsibility of this committee is the smooth conduct of examinations.
- The time tables, seating arrangements of respective examinations are displayed on the college notice board.
- Generated question papers are securely delivered to the student at the time of examination under the observation of the Examination Coordinator.
- The corrected answer scripts shall be distributed to the students for self-evaluation and verification and will be collected by the end of the session.
- The internal assessment mark lists will be recorded and the same shall be displayed in the notice board for a week.
- Internal assessment of the students is also done by giving/conducting Assignments, Presentations, Group Discussion, Personal Interview, Case studies, Role plays, MCQs, Quizzes, Field visit, Summer Internship, Project Dissertation, etc as mentioned above. Assessment/evaluation is done on the basis of the performance of the students and the concerned faculty allocates marks accordingly.
- Within that time, students are free to interact with the teacher to resolve grievances, if any, regarding the assessment marks.

- The concerned teachers are given primary authority and they can resolve the issue on the spot, for example, if there is a change in score, corrigendum will be made on the spot by the concerned teacher.
- The student can make verbal complaints and approach the teachers and/or submit their complaints and drop in the note of dissatisfaction with the internal examination mechanism through online mode/submission or complaint box.
- If and when, there are certain cases where the teachers cannot resolve issues on the spot, such matters will be taken to the Grievance Redressal Cell for immediate action
