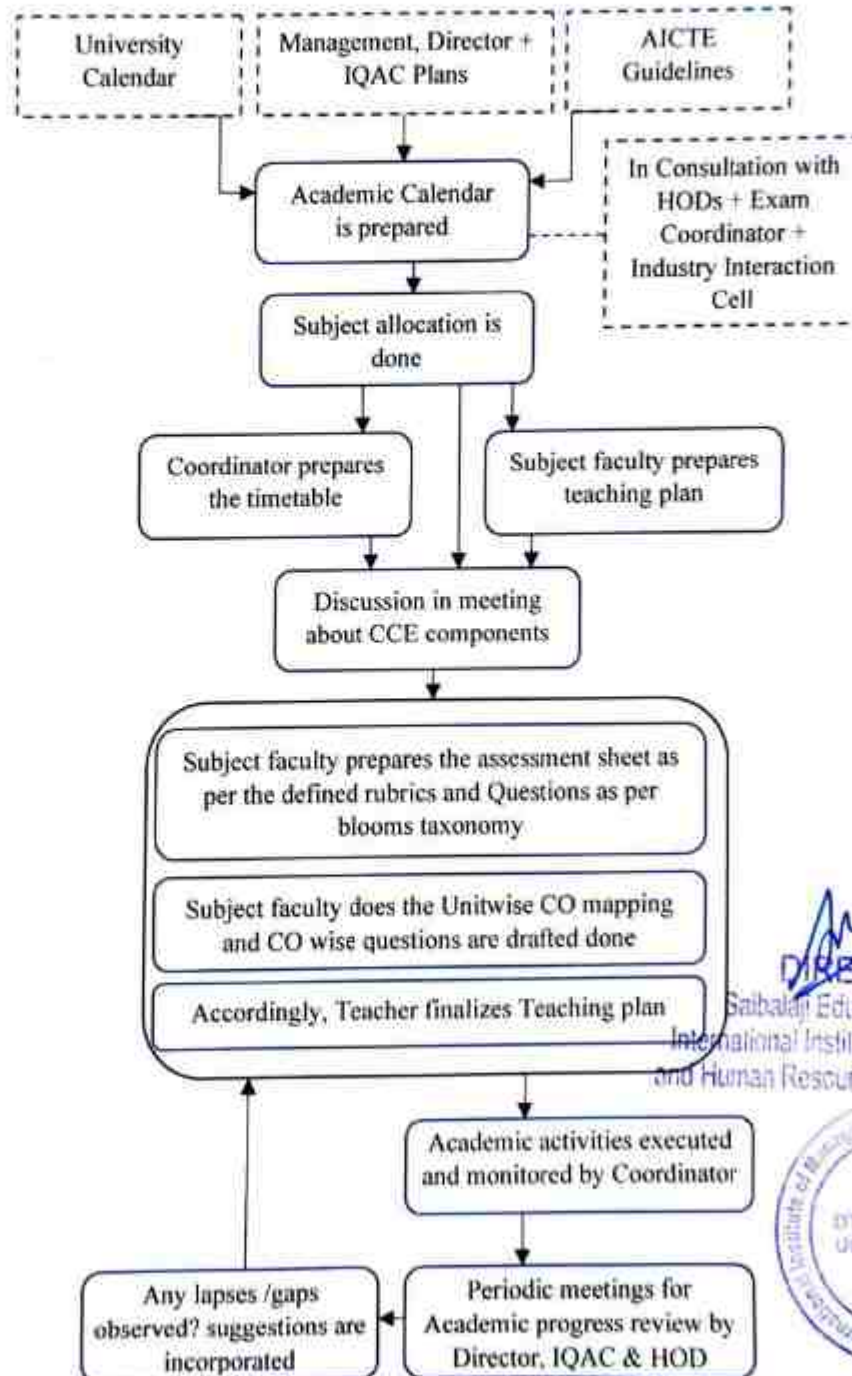

## Effective Curriculum Delivery Process



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### Assessment @ IIMHRD

To ensure transparency, efficiency, and timeliness in dealing with examination-related grievances, IIMHRD has a well-established and time bound mechanism for Examination and Evaluation. Examination Cell is in place for smooth conduction of internal and external examinations. At the beginning of the semester, faculty members inform students about the adopted CCE methods for assessment. Any grievances related to the internal exams are brought to the notice of the concerned teacher and get clarified. External exams are conducted by the University and Institute ensures of arranging the exam in smooth and fair manner with strict vigilance. The evaluation of the university exams held in Centralized Assessment centre as assigned by the affiliating university.

#### Mechanism to conduct Internal Assessment

IIMHRD is affiliated to Pune University and so follows a structured pattern for internal assessment given by the affiliating university. The Comprehensive Concurrent Evaluation designed by SPPU with linkages of each CCE with COs. On those guidelines Institute committee prepares rubrics and makes effective use of the flexibility permitted by SPPU for opting the required CCE approach. Rubrics are designed for respective CCE and assessment strategies.

Each faculty does the internal assessment by opting 3 or 5 CCE components in form of Assignment, class test, presentation, Quiz or discussion forum. Term end exam is conducted by the institute at the end of each semester. Questions and assignments are designed by faculty members according to the bloom's taxonomy.

#### Mechanism of External Assessment

IIMHRD is affiliated to the Pune University. Term-end external assessment is done by university. University sets the Question paper and exam time table. Institute receives the question paper through Institute's exam mail half an hour before the scheduled paper. All answer sheets are dispatched to the Centralized Assessment Centre as allocated by university. University declares the result on university portal.

#### The grievance is resolved in the following manner:

- a) **Departmental Level:** The concurrent evaluation is carried out by faculty regarding theory lectures, labs, assignments, unit tests. The internal marks are allotted based on set Internal Marks policy. Policy is well intimated to students and displayed on the notice board. Any discrepancies regarding the internal marks are discussed with faculty and Departmental head.
- b) **At Institute Level :** IIMHRD has appointed an examination officer and an Internal Senior Supervisor who ensures the smooth conduction of University examinations as directed by University. If students are facing any problems they are solved by the CEO. University



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related grievances like hall-ticket/marksheets corrections, are forwarded to University for corrective measures.

- c) **At University Level** : The queries related to results, Revaluation /Photocopy of answer script, corrections in mark sheets, other certificates issued by university are handled at Examination sections. Students are allowed to apply for revaluation, recounting by paying necessary processing fee to university. University provides photocopy of answer sheets. Students can apply for revaluation if he/she feels that evaluation is not correct. In other cases, like an absentee's case, the application of the student is forwarded to university for corrective action.

## CCE – Comprehensive Concurrent Evaluation Policy

IIMHRD (W) is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune. Institute follows the guidelines and syllabus as prescribed by the Pune University. CCE is for 50 marks. As per the Pune University MBA Syllabus, guidelines are provided for CCE & Rubrics. Accordingly IIMHRD(W) has drafted the following policy for CCE – Comprehensive Concurrent Evaluation.

- The course teacher shall prepare CCE Scheme for their respective subject(s). CCE Scheme could be as per the University prescribed methods (As mentioned in CCE table below)
- For 3 credit course minimum of three CCE methods to be adopted (Each should be of minimum 25 marks. Total marks are then to be converted to 50 marks. For 2 credit course, minimum 2 CCE Schemes, for 1 credit course at least 1 CCE method to be adopted

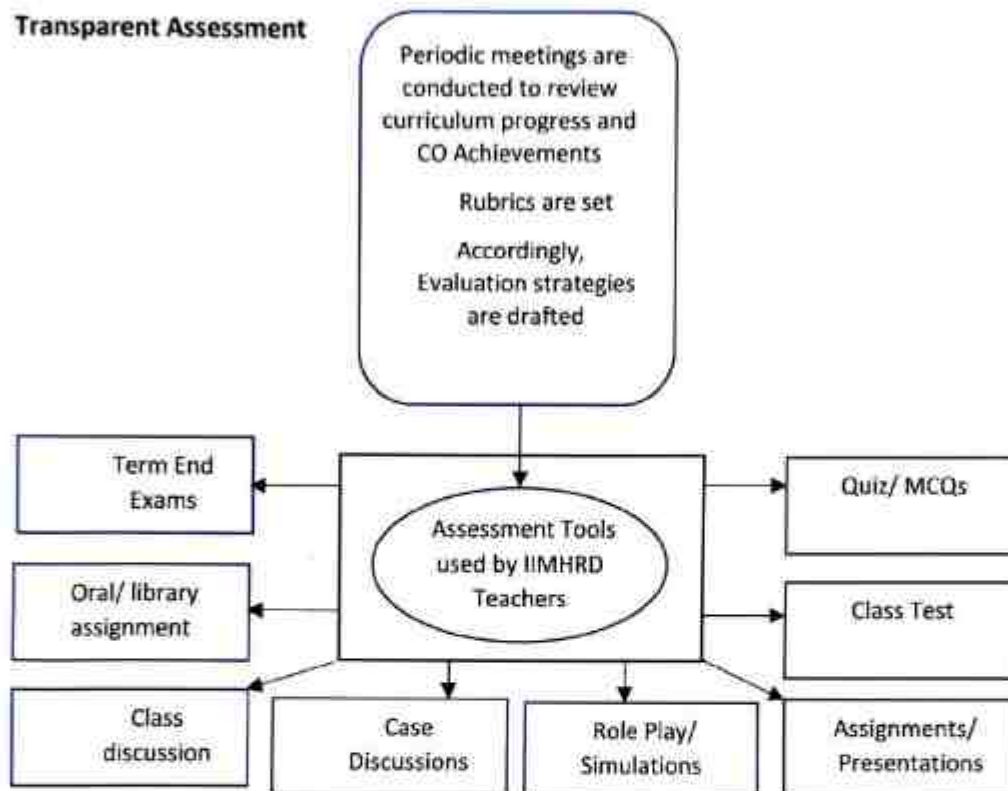

### Mechanism and Conduction of CCE:

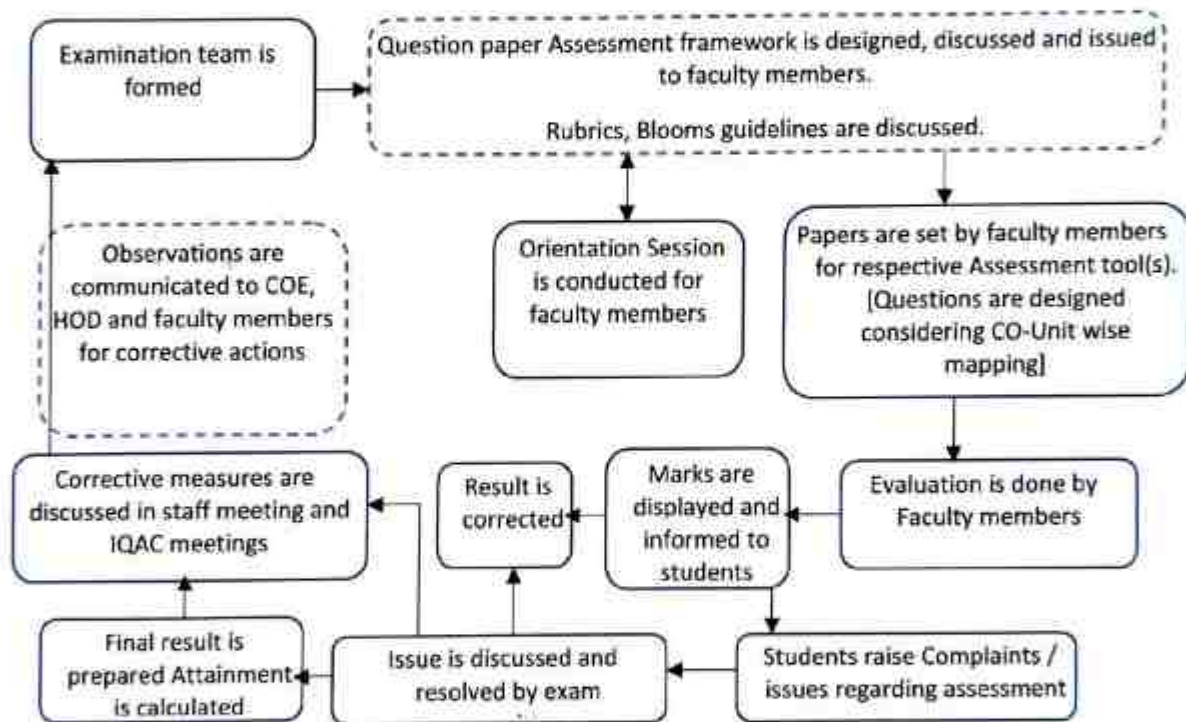
- The scheme of comprehensive concurrent evaluation is prepared by the course teacher and approved by the director of the institute.
- The examination committee takes care of conducting internal examinations. Prime responsibility of this committee is the smooth conduct of examinations.
- The time tables, seating arrangements of respective examinations are displayed on the college notice board.
- Generated question papers are securely delivered to the student at the time of examination under the observation of the Examination Coordinator.
- The corrected answer scripts shall be distributed to the students for self-evaluation and verification and will be collected by the end of the session.
- The internal assessment mark lists will be recorded and the same shall be displayed in the notice board for a week.
- Internal assessment of the students is also done by giving/conducting Assignments, Presentations, Group Discussion, Personal Interview, Case studies, Role plays, MCQs, Quizzes, Field visit.

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Summer Internship, Project Dissertation, etc as mentioned above. Assessment/evaluation is done on the basis of the performance of the students and the concerned faculty allocates marks accordingly.

- Within that time, students are free to interact with the teacher to resolve grievances, if any, regarding the assessment marks.
- The concerned teachers are given primary authority and they can resolve the issue on the spot, for example, if there is a change in score, corrigendum will be made on the spot by the concerned teacher.
- The student can make verbal complaints and approach the teachers and/or submit their complaints and drop in the note of dissatisfaction with the internal examination mechanism through online mode/submission or complaint box.
- If and when, there are certain cases where the teachers cannot resolve issues on the spot, such matters will be taken to the Grievance Redressal Cell for immediate action
